ABILITIES

CORE - Leader

Honour Guard of Macragge

While this unit contains one or more Victrix Honour Guard models, this unit's Marneus Calgar model has the Feel No Pain 4+ ability.

Inspiring Leader

While this model is leading a unit, that unit is eligible to shoot and declare a charge in a turn in which it Advanced or Fell Back.

Master Tactician

At the start of your Command phase, if this unit's Marneus Calgar model is your WARLORD and is on the battlefield, you gain 1CP.

WEAPON RULES

PISTOL

[PISTOL] and [CLOSE-QUARTERS] are identical for all rules purposes.

Units containing one or more models with a [CLOSE-QUARTERS] weapon can shoot using close-quarters shooting (10.06). When using another shooting type, for each model in that unit (excluding MONSTER/VEHICLE models), you can only select one of the following to make attacks with:

- One or more of its [CLOSE-QUARTERS] weapons.
- One or more of its other ranged weapons.

TWIN-LINKED

Each time an attack is made with a [TWIN-LINKED] weapon, you can re-roll the wound roll.

CORE RULES

◆ Leader

Before the battle, in the Muster Armies step, for each leader and support unit in your army, you can select one friendly bodyguard unit that unit can lead. That unit will then lead that bodyguard unit for the battle and form an attached unit with it. Unless otherwise stated, each bodyguard unit can only have one leader unit and one support unit attached to it.
